Subject: **Disciplinary Action Against Indonesian Coach-Tanding Following the Incident at the 31st SEA Games Vietnam, 12-23 May, 2022.**

1. This letter refers to the incident involving Indonesian Coach-Tanding, **Mr. Bondan Wirawan;**
2. The incident involved excessive protest, including jumping onto the competition arena, loud shouting, yelling, and publicly challenging other International Technical Officials (ITOs), actions that led to a viral negative perception of the Pencak Silat competition;
3. After a thorough evaluation of the evidence and in alignment with PERSILAT's Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Regulations, PERSILAT has decided to impose the following sanction:

Mr. Bondan Wirawan, Coach-Tanding, is suspended from participating in any international championship endorsed by PERSILAT for a period of three (3) years, effective from 27 May 2022 to 26 May 2025.

This decision underscores PERSILAT's unwavering commitment to upholding sportsmanship, integrity, and mutual respect within the global Pencak Silat community. We urge IPSI to ensure that this disciplinary outcome is clearly communicated to all relevant parties and to reinforce ethical conduct in all future delegations.

We trust this matter will serve as a constructive reminder of the values that underpin our sport.
