1. IPSI National Working Meeting Year 2022

The National Working Meeting was held at the Multipurpose Building of the Pencak Silat Padepokan, attended by representatives of the IPSI Provincial Boards from all over Indonesia on August 23-25, 2022.



2. Pencak Silat Festival Jurors and Coaches Training

The Festival Jurors and Coaches Training for Artistic Pencak Silat was implemented in Bandung on November 11, 2025. It was participated by 58 participants consisting of 9 Provinces and 4 Perguruan Historis. The activity was opened by the Vice/Acting President of the Executive Board of the Indonesian Pencak Silat Association, Mr. Benny G. Sumarsono.



3. National Level Coaches Training

The National Level Coaches Training was implemented at the Aston Bintaro Hotel on December 2 - 7, 2025.



4. Technical Guidance on the Readiness of a Pencak Silat Toward Olympic

The technical guidance activity was opened by the Vice/Acting President of the Executive Board of the Indonesian Pencak Silat Association, Mr. Benny G. Sumarsono, implemented at the Oakwood Hotel - Jakarta on November 28 - December 1, 2025.



5. Strengthening Human Resources For Pencak Silat Sports Towards Olympic

Mr. Benny G. Sumarsono, as the Vice/Acting President of the Executive Board of the Indonesian Pencak Silat Association, opened the technical guidance activity held at the Vasaka Hotel - East Jakarta on December 2 - 4, 2025.



PENCAK SILAT MATCH ACTIVITIES AT NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL LEVELS

1. 8th Southeast Asia Pencak Silat Championship 2022

The 8th Southeast Asia Pencak Silat Championship 2022 activity was implemented at the OCBC Arena Singapore on February 22-28, 2022. Indonesia won 3 Gold, 3 Silver, and 3 Bronze Medals.



2. Asean University Games 2022

The ASEAN University Games 2022 activity was organized in Ubon Ratchathani, Thailand, from July 26, 2022, to August 6, 2022. Indonesia achieved 5 Gold, 4 Silver, and 1 Bronze Medals.



3. Asean University Games 2024

The ASEAN University Games 2024 was organized in the cities of Surabaya and Malang, Indonesia, carried out from June 25 to July 6, 2024, in East Java Province. In this activity, Indonesia won 13 gold, 5 silver, and 6 bronze.



4. 8th Asian Pencak Silat Championship 2024

The 8th Asian Pencak Silat Championship 2024 was implemented in Uzbekistan on October 7 - 16, 2024. The Indonesian Pencak Silat Team won 12 gold and 2 bronze.



5. 33rd SEA Games 2025- Thailand

The Pencak Silat match at the 2025 SEA Games Thailand took place from December 9 to 17, 2025, with various match classes and artistic forms contested. The nation of Indonesia successfully achieved 4 gold medals, 1 silver, and 7 bronze at the 33rd SEA Games event of the year 2025 in Thailand. The competition was visited by Minister of Youth and Sport H.E. Erick Tohir.



6. International Pencak Silat Indonesian Open Championship 2022

The International Pencak Silat Indonesian Open Championship 2022 was organized at the Pencak Silat Padepokan on August 13 - 17, 2022, participated by 788 Athletes and 6 Countries, namely: Indonesia, the Netherlands, Egypt, Thailand, Malaysia, and Japan.



7. Pencak Silat Exhibition at the Paris 2024 Olympics

The sport of Pencak Silat received the opportunity to perform an Exhibition at the Paris Olympics. The activity was carried out at the Pullman Hotel on July 27, 2024. The performance, which was attended by officials and sports dignities, served as a strategic effort to elevate the global profile of Pencak Silat and support its inclusion in future Olympic Games.



8. 20th World Pencak Silat Championship 2024

The 20th World Pencak Silat Championship 2024 was implemented in the United Arab Emirates on December 18 - 22, 2024. The nation of Indonesia won 11 gold, 7 silver, and 5 bronze.



9. 3rd Junior Asian Pencak Silat Championship 2025

The 3rd Junior Asian Pencak Silat Championship 2025 was implemented on September 25 - 30, 2025, at the Sher-e-Kashmir Indoor Sports Complex, Kashmir - India. The nation of Indonesia achieved third position with an acquisition of 8 gold medals, 1 silver, and 3 bronze.



10. 3rd Asian Youth Games (AYG) 2025

The 3rd Asian Youth Games (AYG) of the Year 2025 was implemented in Manama - Bahrain on October 19-20, 2025. In this Asian-level competition, the nation of Indonesia won first place with the acquisition of one gold medal and one silver. The event was visited by the Ambassador Indonesia for Bahrain H.E. Ardi Hermawan.



11. 14th Asean School Games (ASG) 2025

The 14th Asean School Games (ASG) 2025 was implemented at the Youth Centre, Bandar Seri Begawan - Brunei Darussalam on November 21 - 26, 2025. Indonesia participated in all categories and succeeded in achieving the 1st General Champion position. The medal acquisition achieved consisted of 11 gold medals, 2 silver medals, and 2 bronze medals.



12. 1st Nusantara Championship 2025

The 1st Nusantara Championship was implemented from May 27 to June 1, 2025, in Singapore. It was participated by several countries in Southeast Asia, including Singapore, Indonesia, Malaysia, Brunei Darussalam, and Thailand. The nation of Indonesia won 5 gold and 2 silver.



13. Islamic Solidarity Games 2025

Pencak Silat performed as a demonstration sport discipline in the Islamic Solidarity Games (ISG) Riyadh 2025 on November 6, 2025. Indonesia won one bronze medal. The event was visited by the Ambassador Indonesia for Kingdom of Saudi Arabia H.E. Abdul Aziz Ahmad and the Secretary General of Islamic Solidarity Sports Association (ISSA) Mr. Nasser Ayman Majali.



14. Kudus National Martial Arts Games (PON Beladiri)

The National Martial Arts Games (PON Beladiri) was participated by 34 Provinces across Indonesia, implemented in Kudus - Central Java on October 15 - 22, 2025. For the sport of Pencak Silat, first place was achieved by Central Java Province by acquiring six gold medals and one bronze medal.



15. 19th National Student Sports (POMNAS XIX) Year 2025

The 19th National Student Sports (POMNAS XIX) of the Year 2025 was organized at the Muhammadiyah University of Surakarta (UMS) on September 19-27, 2025. The General Champion was achieved by Central Java Province with an acquisition of eight gold medals, three silver, and seven bronze.



16. National Student Sports Olympiad (O2SN) Year 2022

The National Student Sports Olympiad (O2SN) event for the Sport of Pencak Silat was implemented in a hybrid manner (a combination of online and offline) carried out from July to September 2022 from the Elementary (SD), Junior High (SMP), Senior High (SMA), and Vocational High (SMK) school levels.



17. National Student Sports Olympiad Year 2023

O2SN 2023 was implemented from the Elementary School (SD) level up to the Senior High School (SMA) level.

- O2SN at the SD level was implemented on September 18-24, 2023, at the El Royal Hotel Jakarta.
- O2SN at the SMP level was implemented on September 20-23, 2023, at the Santika Hotel Kelapa Gading.
- O2SN at the SMA level was implemented on September 10-16, 2023, at the El Royal Hotel Jakarta, Jakarta.



18. National Student Sports Olympiad Year 2024

The O2SN activity at the high school level was conducted at the Sunlake Waterfront Resort & Convention Jakarta on August 13 - 16, 2024. The categories contested were Single (*Tunggal*) and Creative Solo (*Solo Kreatif*). The overall total medals competed for were 6 Gold medals, 6 Silver medals, and 10 Bronze medals.



19. National Student Sports Olympiad Elementary (SD) & Junior High School (SMP) Year 2025

The O2SN activity for SD & SMP levels took place at the BBGTK West Java Province Region 3 Parung on November 10-13, 2025. The O2SN at the SD level was participated by 134 participants from 33 provinces and overseas participants. The O2SN at the SMP level was participated by 133 participants from 33 provinces and participants.



20. National Student Sports Olympiad Senior High (SMA) & Vocational School (SMK) Year 2025

The National Student Sports Olympiad (O2SN) for the sport of Pencak Silat at the SMA and SMK levels was implemented on November 16 - 21, 2025, and the closing ceremony of O2SN was carried out on November 22, 2025.



21. 21st National Sports (PON XXI) Year 2024

The 21st National Sports (PON XXI) was held in the Provinces of Aceh and North Sumatra, participated by 32 Provinces in Indonesia. The Pencak Silat matches were implemented on September 9 - 13, 2024, at GOR Veteran, Medan - North Sumatra. The General Champion of the National Sports Week (PON XXI) for the sport of Pencak Silat was achieved by West Java Province with an acquisition of five gold, five silver, and three bronzes.



22. National Junior Pencak Silat Championship

The National Championship (Kejurnas) of Pencak Silat for the Junior Category was implemented at the GOR of the Taman Mini Indonesia Indah (TMII) Pencak Silat Padepokan on September 3 - 7, 2025. This championship was participated by 143 athletes from 25 provinces with the breakdown of 75 male athletes and 68 female athletes. The 1st General Champion was achieved by Central Java Province with an acquisition of four gold medals, one silver, and one bronze.



23. Ministry of Youth and Sport's International Pencak Silat Championship 2025

The Kemenpora International Pencak Silat Championship 2025 was held at the Pencak Silat Padepokan from July 10, 2025, up to July 13, 2025. The General Champion was achieved by Silat Bangau Ruyung Kudus.
